### **44/22 APPOINTMENT OF CITY DIRECTOR**

The Mayor explained the background to the appointment. The City Director's post had been advertised in several ways since the previous postholder's departure, i.e. part-time or full-time, or simply a new Town Clerk. No interest had been expressed. It would seem that other community councils are finding it difficult to fill similar posts.

The present acting town clerk had shown an interest in applying for the post and a small panel had interviewed him the previous week. The panel already felt that Martin Hanks was an extremely capable town clerk, and that this augured well for the challenge of being City Director. Another strength was that he is bilingual.

Advice had been sought from Gwilym Rippon from the SATC with regard to making the appointment without a further advertisement. His advice was that if an individual had the necessary skills and qualities, then it was proper and lawful to appoint from within, following an interview with a small panel.

Therefore, the Mayor asked Members to endorse the appointment and to deputise to the Mayor the right to offer the post to Martin Hanks.

**IT WAS RESOLVED** unanimously to offer the post of City Director to Mr Martin Hanks, on a full-time basis.

**ALSO** to delegate to the appointments sub committee the authority to decide terms and conditions of appointment.

The meeting came to an end at 6.55 pm

This was followed by a CLOSED AND CONFIDENTIAL meeting of the Appointments Sub-Committee, where the postholder's salary, terms and conditions were discussed.
